Key Note Speaker, Lene Espersen

We are proud to introduce former minister and former party leader Lene F. Espersen as the Convention Key Note speaker.

Lene Espersen was born in 1965, and is married, with 2 children. Lene Espersen is a very active and informed woman, involved in many fields, and has a great number of prizes to her name, including in 1996 “Outstanding Young Person of the Year” by JCI Denmark, and in 2002 and 2009, “Business Woman of the Year”, among several others. She has twice been top vote scorer at a Danish general election for the Conservative Party.

Lene Espersen has a Msc in advanced economics and finance from Aarhus University, where she studied from 1984-1990, and was a member of the Danish parliament for the Conservative party from 1994 to 2011. During her time in office, she was Minister of Justice from 2001 to 2008. From 2008 to 2010 Lene Espersen served as Minister of Business and Economy, and from 2010 to 2011 Lene Espersen served as Minister of Foreign Affairs. Besides being a minister and member of Parliament, Lene Espersen was Party Leader of the Conservative Party and Deputy Prime Minister. From 2011 to 2014 Lene Espersen continued as a member of Parliament, leaving political life for a position as Managing Director of the Organization of Danish Architects.

Lene Espersen’s personal values and philosophy are: self- confidence, hard work, honesty and clarity, personal responsibility and the aim to build bridges between differing opinions. Lene Espersen likes to act proactively, think fast and plan ahead, and she finds it very important to maintain a good balance between her work life and her private life, also encouraging her employees to adopt the same strong focus on their work/life balance.



She has managed leadership positions in her professional life through some turbulent times, and accepts that nobody is perfect, including herself! But she places an emphasis on understanding how to enhance personal strengths, and working on weaknesses, and this has been of great value to her personally.

There are ATMs usually located in connection with a bank branch, which accept a variety of international credit cards. The cards accepted are indicated on the dispenser.

Currency/credit cards

The currency in Denmark is Danish Kroner (DKK). One krone is divided into 100 Øre. 1 Euro is approx. 7.5 DKK and 1 USD is approx. 6.8 DKK as per April 2015. Most shops and restaurants accept Euro, but at a higher rate. Credit cards are widely accepted – also in taxis.

The shops are open from 09:30/10:00 to 18:00/19:00 hrs. Monday through Thursday and 09:30/10:00 to 20:00 on Friday and 09:00 to 17:00 on Saturday/Sunday.
